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THIS Service can be sung by either men, or women, or both. If by men only, it may be advisable to use the alternatives printed in small notes, thus avoiding the high notes. Choirmasters can use their discretion in apportioning various passages to different groups. Antiphonal singing can be arranged between men and women, men and boys, choir and congregation, or between a few voices and the whole choir. There are other places besides those marked in the Evening Service where this may be done.

It is possible to play the accompaniment on an instrument without pedals. If this is done, the small notes should be omitted, and also the pedal part when it is an octave below the next part above.


